

the ethos of giving back to society is ingrained in our DNA. Long before the advent of the CSR Act, we were actively engaged in community development initiatives. Our commitment to sustainability, which entails integrating social and environmental development into our business strategies, underscores our dedication to inclusive growth. In alignment with this vision, alongside our ongoing efforts in skill development, education, and community development, we have embarked on a transformative endeavour: the "Village Development Project." The pillars of our Village Development Project ensures access to water for agriculture and drinking purposes, augmenting livelihood opportunities, improving internal infrastructure such as roads, fostering education, and promoting healthcare services. These initiatives are meticulously aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG)

Our CSR team, supported by various partners, ensures each village progresses towards a self-sustaining future. This work aims to make urban to rural migration a desired trend, reversing current patterns.

Besides rural development in 5 districts of Maharashtra state and our skills development efforts, now in future we would like to extend our efforts of development in northeastern states and aspirational areas. We would focus on education, skill development, and higher education for girls through the Vidyanjali project.

Besides Rural development initiatives under CSR we are contributing to Skill Development Initiatives. Before the concept of Public Private Partnership (PPP) was introduced, we signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Government of Maharashtra and established "a model Industrial Training Institute (ITI)" at Khed, ensuring 100% placement of its students every year. Additionally, we partner with other ITIs to provide quality training and infrastructure development. At ITI Khed, we have set up a CNC simulation lab to equip students with the necessary industry skills. Furthermore, we have established a Center of Excellence at Vidya Pratishthan in Baramati, focusing on high-tech skills such as Robotics, IoT, AI, Machine Learning, and Data Analytics. Incubation centre to promote start-ups is also established here. We prioritize women's empowerment, with over 60% of our students being girls.

Since 2017, we have been dedicated to sustainability and environmental conservation. Our efforts include - Water Harvesting Projects: We have undertaken numerous projects, such as building bunds, desilting rivers, and setting up pipelines in drought-prone villages in Maharashtra and harvested 2625TCM of water. We have planted and cultivated over 2,37,000 trees. We have installed 469 KW solar panels in government schools and on water-supplying wells in villages. We have set up 1,090 composter planters for waste management in urban communities. This initiative has reduced 483.3 Tons of kitchen waste.

These initiatives underscore our commitment to creating green villages and societies. This year, we applied for certification from the Indian Green Building Council (IGBC) for 6 villages in Satara. Our efforts have successfully transformed rural areas into serene green villages. Thereby achieving Platinum and gold rating. These certifications from the Indian Green Building Council (IGBC) reflect our significant progress in advancing sustainability and community well-being.

Under the guidance of top management we have transformed over 2,13,000 lives in more than 100 villages, focusing on sustainable water management and improving access to markets through better roads. Our various initiatives also include enhancing livelihood, vocational training to rural youth, education to under privileged, women empowerment and skill development programs, enhancing the livelihoods of over 3000 trainees at our Industrial Training Institutes.

We have decided to expand our reach to include the northeast as part of our work area. This strategic shift aims to address unique regional challenges and promote sustainable development. Emphasizing our commitment to creating selfreliant community, we have certified 6 villages as Green Villages and next year we are planning to assessed 8 more villages for getting Green Village certification. These efforts ensure the well-being of the most vulnerable in these communities, and through our CSR efforts, we are aiming to include the last person in the growth process of our country.

Bharat Forge has significantly improved water harvesting, transforming landscapes and enhancing lives. Our initiatives, including the construction of Bandharas and desilting existing water bodies, have increased water storage capacities and boosted agricultural productivity. Key projects, such as Chilewadi and Amondi, have improved water availability for drinking and irrigation, leading to higher crop yields and better livelihoods. In Wagholi and Belewadi, efforts like river deepening and extensive desilting have enabled farmers to cultivate multiple crops annually, enhancing their income and food security while improving the quality of available water.

Additionally, the intervention at Visapur village, involving the construction and renovation of Bandharas, has enhanced groundwater recharge, reduced soil erosion, and improved agricultural productivity. These projects demonstrate Bharat Forge's commitment to sustainable water management, ensuring long-term benefits for community well-being. By investing in these initiatives, we continue to support the development and sustainability of the communities we serve.

Guntha in 2023-24 were successfully leveled, benefiting 105 farmers.

Our initiatives have been instrumental in transforming barren land into fertile fields, significantly enhancing agricultural output and improving livelihoods. Through land leveling and soil treatment, previously unproductive land is now yielding abundant crops, providing farmers with a reliable source of income. Additionally, farmers have been trained in modern agricultural practices, leading to a substantial increase in crop production, including staple crops like wheat, rice, and maize, as well as cash crops such as vegetables and fruits.

We have also facilitated direct access to markets for farmers, helping them get better prices for their produce resulting in increasing in overall income.



Cancer screening camps & medicine center

Our cancer screening programs focus on early detection and prevention, conducting regular screenings for common cancers and providing education on prevention and the importance of regular screenings. These initiatives aim to catch cancer in its early stages when treatment is most effective. Health education sessions cover topics like nutrition, hygiene, maternal and child health, and chronic disease management. We collaborate with local health authorities to complement existing services, ensuring efficient resource use and a sustainable, lasting impact of our programs. Community engagement and feedback are integral to tailoring our programs to meet local needs effectively. Our goal is to empower communities with knowledge and resources to improve overall health outcomes.



Bringing Healing Home

Telemedicine Centers Across 8 Villages

Bharat Forge's health initiatives aim to extend quality healthcare to remote areas, ensuring underserved communities receive necessary medical services. Telemedicine centers in eight villages provide virtual consultations, diagnostic services, and follow-up care, connecting residents with medical professionals without the need for long travel. Additionally, we also conducts the outreach activity where the telemedicine staff reaches out to the houses of the people.

SUSTENANCE

In villages across the region, trees are being planted to bring back lush landscapes, and solar panels are installed to harness the sun's clean energy. Additionally, waste management systems are being improved to ensure a cleaner, more sustainable environment. These efforts mark a stride towards a greener future, reducing ecological footprints and fostering sustainable practices within the community.

Harnessing the Sun

Solar panels convert sunlight into reliable electricity, ensuring that even remote villages have stable power and reducing dependency on unstable energy sources. This initiative has been implemented for the villages belonging to the division of Satara, Pune, Ahmednagar, Osmanabad.

Green Canopies

Trees purify the air by absorbing carbon dioxide and releasing oxygen, enhancing air quality and combating climate change. BFL's tree plantation drives have transformed landscapes and contributed to environmental health. In Thakarwadi, Amondi, and Valunjwadi, thousands of saplings have been planted, benefiting local ecosystems. These green canopies provide shade, reduce soil erosion, and support biodiversity, creating a healthier environment.

Waste Management

Proper waste management prevents pollution by safely disposing of hazardous materials and promoting recycling, keeping our community clean. In Hadapsar, Pune, BFL's waste management project in this year has installed over 500 Composter Planters, converting organic kitchen waste into quality manure. This initiative, part of the "My Waste My Responsibility" campaign, has reached 1,090 families, promoting sustainable practices by providing high-quality compost. Regular training sessions for community members ensure effective use of composters, raising awareness about waste segregation and recycling.

CII Exibition

Bharat Forge's CSR & ESG projects took the spotlight at the 'Exhibition on Embracing ESG in India' which was organized by the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs in collaboration with NITI Aayog and the Ministry of Finance's Department of Public Enterprise. The event took place on December 14th and 15th, 2023, at the India Habitat Center in New Delhi. The event was inaugurated by Shri Rao Indrajit Singh, Hon'ble Minister of State for Ministry of Planning, Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MOSPI); Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) along with Mr. Manoj Govil, Secretary Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Mr. Shombi Sharp, UN resident coordinator to India and other higher dignitaries were also present. BFL was among the 22 exhibitors to showcase our impactful ESG and CSR projects to these esteemed government officials and other stakeholders.





Harnessing the sun









In the year 2023-24, our team installed solar panels across the divisions of Satara, Purandar, Osmanabad, and Ahmednagar, targeting villages to reduce the burden of electricity bill. This initiative successfully generated over 288.5 KW of electricity, significantly enhancing the energy resources of these communities. By providing a reliable and clean energy source, we've helped improve the living standards in these areas, demonstrating our commitment to promoting environmental sustainability through renewable energy solutions.

This large-scale effort aimed to enhance the green cover and contribute to the ecological balance in these regions. By increasing the tree population, we've not only improved air quality but also supported local biodiversity, reinforcing our commitment to environmental sustainability and community well-being.

Waste Management








In the year 2023-24, under our environmental sustainability initiatives, we tackled waste management challenges by removing 911.405 tonnes of organic waste from 81 societies. Recognizing the growing waste management issues in urban areas, our efforts focused on raising awareness about organic waste management and supporting individual households in effectively managing their waste. We provided 1,000 composters, in collaboration with an NGO partner, to help convert 800 kg of organic waste into manure daily, totaling approximately 24,000 kg each month. This initiative not only mitigates waste but also promotes sustainable urban living, striving to transform these communities into "Green Housing Societies."

Bharat Forge is at the forefront of skill development, having established strategic partnerships with four Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in Khed, Bhor, Malegaon, and Karjat. These collaborations are aimed at revolutionizing infrastructure and elevating the quality of education offered, with a keen focus on empowering women through cutting-edge technological skills. In particular, we are channeling our efforts into areas like Artificial Intelligence (AI), Machine Learning, and the Internet of Things (IoT). By integrating these advanced fields into our curricula, we are preparing our students-especially women-for the demands of modern industry, ensuring they are not just participants but leaders in the technological landscape.

Here's What We're Doing

- Educational facilities are being enhanced to provide state-of-the-art learning environments at each ITI.
- Specialized workshops and seminars deepen students' understanding of AI, Machine Learning, and IoT.
- Mentorship programs connect students with industry leaders, fostering practical, hands-on experience.
- Collaborative projects are initiated to apply theoretical knowledge in real-world scenarios, bridging the gap between education and industry demands.

Centre of Excellence

Vidya Pratishthan Baramati has established the Centre of Excellence (CoE) for Youth Development and an Incubation Centre in collaboration with Bharat Forge Pune under the CSR initiative of Bharat Forge. The centre is established at Vidya Pratishthan's Kamalnayan Bajaj Institute of Engineering and Technology Baramati.

The CoE provides an environment for students to learn and experiment different software tools to carry out their projects, product development and research work. This project ensures maximum participation of girl students. The center also provides support for training programs, short term courses and technical workshops in emerging technologies.

CNC Simulation Lab

The Digital CNC Simulator Lab at ITI Khed, Rajgurunagar, has been established to provide students with a virtual understanding of the programming required for CNC machine operation. This initiative benefits over 150 students from various trades including Turner, Machinist, and Tool & Die maker, offering them hands-on experience in advanced technical skills.

The setup not only aids ITI students in mastering CNC operations but also supports nearby industries by enhancing their employees' skills in CNC programming. As a result, the entire industrial cluster of Khed will experience significant advantages from this initiative.

By investing in education, we're not just teaching skills; we're nurturing future leaders who will inspire and elevate their communities. This commitment builds a foundation of strong values and social responsibility, preparing children to thrive in a changing world.

Here's What We're Doing

- Engaging hands-on sessions like Craft, Clay & Creative Activities, and Drawing foster creativity and practical skills among village students.
- Comprehensive educational support through Subject Teaching Activities in Math, Marathi, and English, alongside Exercise Activities and Summer Camps, enhances both academic and physical development.
- Cultural enrichment and community engagement are emphasized through Cultural Festivals, Parent Meetings, and Prize Distribution Programs, fostering a strong sense of community and achievement.
- The Pradnya Vikas Program, executed in collaboration with Jnana prabodhini reached over 200 students, significantly impacting their educational journey.

Pratham

Pratham Pune Education Foundation, supported by Bharat Forge, provides informal education to underprivileged children in slum areas of Pune, reaching out to 5000 children to improve literacy and educational outcomes. Key components include Balshikshan, Setushikshan and Kishorshikshan programs to help school children reintegrate into formal education, community-based learning centers offering resources and support, and parental involvement through workshops to encourage educational engagement. Innovative teaching methods and regular assessments ensure learning is engaging and effective, with tailored support based on each child's progress.

Pradnya Vikas is a fast-track developmental program for children, focusing on holistic growth and education. It offers a comprehensive curriculum that covers academics, life skills, and extracurricular activities to ensure well-rounded development. The program includes extracurricular activities like sports, arts, and cultural events to build confidence and community. Career counseling and guidance on higher education help students make informed decisions about their futures, while community involvement projects foster social responsibility.

Anubhav Shala provides experiential learning opportunities to enhance students' practical skills and knowledge. The program emphasizes hands-on learning through activities, experiments, and field trips, allowing students to apply theoretical concepts in real-world scenarios. It is an initiative for the children who belongs to underprivileged background and studying from 1st to 6th standard. Currently we have 5 centres of Anubhav Shala running at different locations of Pune that are located at Community Center (Keshav Nagar), Gairan vasti (Keshav Nagar), Mahatma Phule Vasti (Hadapsar), Jay Bhavani nagar (Kothrud), Kakde Vasti (Kondhwa). Collaborative learning is promoted through group activities, while regular evaluations and feedback help students identify strengths and areas for improvement, keeping them focused on their goals.

Mentorship Program

Mentorship program offers comprehensive support to 45 girl students, ensuring they have the necessary resources and guidance for academic success. The program provides financial assistance through scholarships and aid to economically disadvantaged students, eliminating financial barriers to education. Essential study materials like textbooks and stationery are supplied, ensuring students are well-equipped for their studies. Additionally, we offer personalized support to help students overcome academic challenges by providing career guidance and counseling to students, helping them in exploring career options and making informed decisions about their future.


Honors & Accolades IGBC Green Village Awards
